The animals that populate his menagerie sound like Octavia Spencer, Emma Thompson, Rami Malek, Kumail Nanjiani, Tom Holland, Ralph Feinnes and Marion Cotillard. 

Filmmaker Terrence Malick (THE THIN RED LINE, TREE OF LIFE) returns with another gorgeous and powerfully engrossing story, this one of a conscientious objector during WW2. August Diehl (INGLOURIOUS BASTERDS) is a peasant farmer in bucolic Austria who, refusing to swear an oath to Hitler, is supported by his loving wife (Valerie Pachner) but not his community. Matthias Schoenaerts plays a neighbor trying to convince the farmer to change his mind, along with co-stars and late actors Swede Michael Nyqvist and Swiss Bruno Ganz who both give their final roles. This true story explores the strength required for resistance and the courage required to hold convictions.

Director Sam Mendes (SKYFALL, AMERICAN BEAUTY), inspired by his grandfather's war stories, has created a potent, propulsive and stirring film, photographed to resemble a single take by veteran cinematographer Roger Deakins (FARGO, BLADERUNNER 2049). Two young British soldiers during WWI are sent on a perilous mission across enemy territory and no-man's land to deliver an urgent message, hopefully preventing a massacre, to the commander of a platoon about to advance into a trap, a group that includes the messenger's brother.

Knives Out

This purely enjoyable comedic murder mystery from filmmaker Rian Johnson (LOOPER, THE LAST JEDI) pays tribute to Agatha Christie. The star-studded ensemble cast includes Jamie Lee Curtis, Chris Evans, Don Johnson, Toni Collette and Michael Shannon as the dysfunctional children and grandchildren of a wealthy patriarch (Christopher Plummer) who is found dead under suspicious circumstances just after his 85th birthday, and his family are all suspects. Daniel Craig plays a mysteriously hired private detective tasked with figuring out who-done-it.

JUST MERCY

Michael B. Jordan gives a strong performance as Harvard-educated defense attorney Bryan Stevenson, a young lawyer in the late 1980's who moved to Alabama to work with death-row inmates in this powerful and absorbing tale of social justice. Based on true events, he takes on pro-bono appeals for several men facing execution, discovering an innocent man falsely accused (Jamie Foxx) as well as helping a man who has admitted his crime (Rob Morgan). (Stevenson has since gone on to become a visionary leader in criminal justice reform.) The excellent cast in this absorbing true story that questions the appropriateness of the death penalty from director Destin Daniel Cretton (SHORT TERM 12) includes Brie Larson, Tim Blake Nelson, Rafe Spall, and O'Shea Jackson Jr.



BAD BOYS FOR LIFE

Will Smith and Martin Lawrence have terrific chemistry as buddy cops in 1990's Miami in this quite silly but action-packed and lots of fun sequel (to Michael Bay's first two entries begun 25 years ago), directed with flair by Belgian team Adil El Arbi and Bilal Fallah, a film you didn't know you wanted. They are inseparable crime-fighters, except that one has become a grandpa and would like to retire from all this crime-fighting and explore life in his recliner, while the other is going to do it until he dies, and please won't he help figure out who's trying to kill him?
